Events in 2023:

Spring Fling Luncheon - April 19, 2023

CCRA's Spring Fling Luncheon held on April 19, 2023 was well attended. The Event Centre provided a delicious lunch and desserts. The guest speaker, Renee Procenko presented an interactive and engaging talk on "How to Clear Your Clutter". The chatter after Renee's talk seemed to have energized our members to take on the task of clearing their clutter regardless how large or small a task.

For those of you who were unable to attend our Spring Fling, below is a step-by-step plan to follow on "How to Declutter":

1. There are five essential boxes required for this declutter method: trash, recycle, donate, to-do and transit.

2. Declutter one section at a time of the area being decluttered and place the items in the appropriate box.

3. Set a 20-minute time limit as you begin each section to ensure the decluttering task does not become overwhelming.

4. The most important task is deciding what box is the most appropriate for your items.

5. Deciding what to keep can be daunting, so Renee Procenko suggested to ask yourself, 1.

"Do I absolutely love it?, 2. Will I use it? and 3. Will I display it?".

6. If it is not a "yes" to question (1) and not a firm yes to either question (2) or (3), then the item is not a "keeper".

7. In cases where there are three or more of the same item, ask yourself, "Do I need to keep all three items or will keeping only one suffice?"

Fall Update from the CAAT Pension Plan

New features have been added to My Pension, CAAT Pension Plan's online portal. If you receive a CAAT pension, it's time to activate your My Pension account. My Pension, CAAT's online portal, gives you secure access to your personalized pension information.

With My Pension you can:

- See your monthly pension amount.
- Check the date of your next payment.
- Manage your contact information.
- View digital copies of your annual statement and other correspondence.
- Send secure messages to CAAT's pension experts using the Message Centre.

New features coming soon!

- Update your bank account information.
- Adjust the income tax deducted from your monthly pension payment. Be sure to consult a tax professional before making any changes.
- 2023 tax slips will be available to download by the end of February and will be stored on My Pension so you can access them any time that's convenient for you. Tax slips will not be mailed to members who prefer digital correspondence. Update your preference today! You'll get an email from us when your tax slips are ready and any time you need to log in to check your messages.

It's easy to get started!

- 1. Visit "caatpension.ca/signin" on your computer or tablet to activate your account.
- 2. Verify your identity by entering your member ID (look on your annual statement or any correspondence from CAAT), date of birth and last three digits of your SIN.
- 3. Follow the prompts to create a password, set up your security questions and set your communication preferences. Choose "online" to get your pension information on My Pension instead of by mail.

Centennial In the News

Centennial College has opened the doors to the A-Building - Canada's first LEED Gold, zero carbon, mass timber, higher education building. The building formerly known as the A-Block, establishes a new gateway to Centennial's flagship Progress Campus that supports indigenous ways of being and teaching.

An indigenous Working Group made vital contributions to Indigenous elements of the Build. The building spans six storeys and more than 130,000 square feet. The expansion was accompanied by a 15,000 square-foot renovation.

Students, staff and faculty have been welcomed into an inclusively and sustainably designed building guided by the Indigenous concept of "two-eyed seeing", or viewing the world through the lens of both indigenous and Western knowledge.

Indigenous ways of being and teaching are at the heart of A-Building, which is also home to administrative offices, collaborative areas, food services and space for the School of Engineering Technology and Applied Science.

There is an interior courtyard that serves as an outdoor classroom, which allows teaching in a circle formation, among other flexible classrooms. Thirteen rooms equipped with special exhaust fans make it possible for smudging to occur.

A-Building has achieved zero carbon certification thanks in large part to a highly efficient building envelope, along with all-electric domestic hot water heating and HVAC systems. On August 23, 2023, members of the Indigenous helped bring the A-Building to life through a series of ceremonies and a community drum social.
